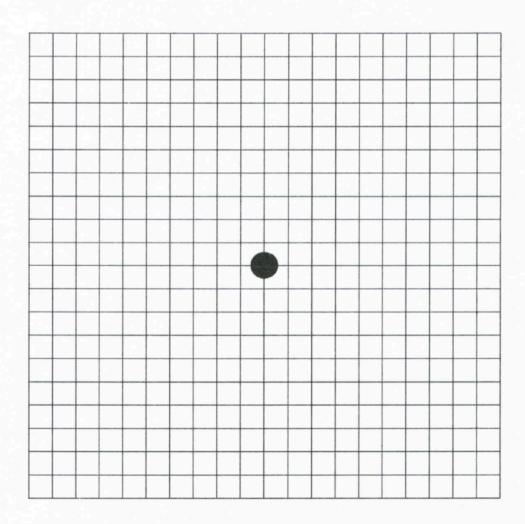
AMSLER GRID EYE EXAM

The Amsler Grid may be helpful in revealing signs of Wet Age-Related Macular Degeneration (AMD). It is NOT a substitute for regularly scheduled eye exams.

- 1. Do not remove glasses or contacts you normally wear for reading.
- 2. Stand approximately 13 inches from the grid in a well-lighted room.
- 3. Cover one eye with your hand and focus on the center dot with your uncovered eye. Repeat with other eye.
- 4. If you see wavy, broken or distorted lines, or blurred or missing areas of vision, you may be displaying symptoms of AMD and should contact your eye care provider immediately.
